(K-5th Grade)**

**CAMP MENORAH MITZVAH  
(6th-7th Grade)**

Our oldest group will help plan and run camp programs, as well as participate in leadership training, special trips, and their own service projects on campus and at Wilderness Park.

Ready to take on leadership opportunities? Our CITs will learn specific traits of effective leaders, gaining insight into the importance of these characteristics & skills, then put those skills into action as role models and leaders around camp.

**STAFF**

All staff members are required to complete a staff training program, including CPR and First Aid certification. Counselors and CITs are chosen for their enthusiasm, experience, skills, Judaic knowledge and caring attitude. High schoolers are eligible for community service hours if desired (no tuition for CITs in 11th-12th grades).
